

华东师范大学和昆士兰大学本科 2+2 联合培养项目

昆士兰大学理学部地球与环境科学学院的地理学在 [2019 年世界大学学术排名](#) 中名列全澳第一。

地环院的地球科学家、物理和社会科学家、环境管理专家、健康和专家以及城市规划师团队共同努力，应对人口增长，气候变化，城市化，粮食安全，自然资源保护等日益严峻的全球化挑战。

昆士兰大学与华东师范大学开设了本科 2+2 联合培养项目。参与本科 2+2 项目的同学可以在完成华东师范大学理学学士（地理科学或地理信息科学）大二的学习后，进入昆士兰大学的理学学士（地理科学专业）继续完成本科后两年的学习。学成后将获得华东师范大学及昆士兰大学授予的学士学位证书



澳大利亚，昆士兰州，布里斯班市

澳大利亚联邦（英语：The Commonwealth of Australia），简称“澳大利亚”（Australia）。领土面积约 769 万平方公里，位于南太平洋和印度洋之间，四面环海，是世界上唯一国土覆盖一整个大陆的国家，因此也称“澳洲”。拥有很多独特的动植物和自然景观的澳大利亚，是一个奉行多元文化的移民国家。

澳大利亚地处南半球，虽然时差与中国只有 2-3 小时，但是季节却完全相反。12-2 月为夏季，3 月-5 月为秋季，6-8 月为冬季，9-11 月为春季。年平均气温北部 27 摄氏度，南部 14 摄氏度。

澳大利亚是典型的移民国家，被社会学家喻为“民族的拼盘”。自英国移民踏上这片美丽的土地之日起，已先后有来自世界 120 个国家、140 个民族的移民到澳大利亚谋生和发展。2019 年人口普查数据表明，总人口为 2 千 5 百万的澳大利亚，每 5 个人中就有一个是海外出生。74% 为英国及爱尔兰裔，5.6% 为华裔，2.8% 为土著人口，其他族裔主要有意大利裔、德裔和印度裔等。

澳大利亚昆士兰大学(The University of Queensland) 坐落于澳大利亚第三大城市，昆士兰州(Queensland) 的首府——布里斯班(Brisbane)。这座被 Rough Guides (罗浮旅游指南) 评为世界最美城市第八位的魅力都市，有着宜人的居住环境和天气气候，四季平均气温在 21-28 摄氏度，全年有

超过 300 天的晴天，是名副其实的阳光之州 (Sunshine State)。而相较于澳大利亚的其他大都会，布里斯班有着更高的生活成本性价比，留学成本更为相宜。

约三分之一在海外出生的居民以及近 5 万的国际留学生，为这个城市带来了友善包容的国际化、多民族、多元化的人文氛围，能够让每个国际留学生同时感受到家的温暖和异国的精彩。澳大利亚是一个以优良自然环境著称的国家，而布里斯班更是其中的佼佼者，全城超过 2000 座的绿植公园，让这里成为澳大利亚乃至全球绿化环境最好的城市之一。

布里斯班的年经济增长率超过 4 个百分点，在澳大利亚的首府中经济增长速度最快，这为出色的毕业生提供了就业机会，许多留学生都选择留在这个城市，并成为我们充满活力的人才团队中的一员。

布里斯班市政府及布里斯班推广局自 2009 年开始实施一项吸引国际学生的志愿者计划 - “布里斯班留学生国际大使”。每年布里斯班市长都会任命 40 位国际学生大使，他们在社交媒体上与同龄人、未来留学生和海外家庭分享他们在布里斯班的学习生活经历。截至今年为止，十年间来自中国、印度、韩国、巴西、马来西亚、新加坡、沙特阿拉伯、日本、哥伦比亚、美国及德国 40 多个国家的 400 多位国际学生先后被任命为布里斯班留学生国际大使。

布里斯班的生活成本

布里斯班是澳大利亚公认的性价比最高的城市，拥有一线城市的繁华，生活成本却远低于悉尼墨尔本这些大城市。布里斯班实惠的物价很受国际学生欢迎，根据全球性数据库网站 NUMBEO 的

数据，布里斯班一个月的生活费用为 **1063 澳元** (不包括租房费用)；而悉尼和墨尔本一个月的生活费用分别为 **1362 澳元** 以及 **1312 澳元**。

昆士兰大学

为自己选择一所合适的大学是一项重大的人生抉择，特别是当您决定出国留学时。

一所声誉卓著，能够帮助学生充分发挥潜力，同时，其师资屡获高度嘉奖并能与学生息息相通的大学，是每个求学者梦寐以求的。其次，学习环境是否优良，是否能培养出各行业领导型人才，也是择校的其中一条重要指标。另外，能够丰富学生留学生活、在课堂以外促进学生的学习与个人成长的课外活动也不可或缺。最重要的是，校园必须要安全、友善、多元化。

昆士兰大学 (The University of Queensland 简称 UQ)，1909 年 12 月 10 日成立于昆士兰州首府布里斯班，为昆士兰州的第一所综合型大学。目前在校生约五万人，是 6 所砂岩学府 Sandstone universities 之一；澳大利亚八大名校 Group of Eight 的盟校成员，也是 Universitas 21 联盟的一员，是澳大利亚历史最悠久和最享有盛誉的大学之一。

澳大利亚网站 QILT(Quality Indicators for Learning and Teaching)发布了最新的 2018 年度学生体验调查(Student Experience Survey)。SES 由澳大利亚政府教育和培训部门资助，是目前澳大利亚高等教育学生的唯一的综合调查问卷。来自澳大利亚大学和非大学高等教育机构(NUHEIs)的约 19.4 万名本科生和 8.9 万名研究生参与了此次调查，该调查旨在收集有助于高等教育机构和政府改善教学和学习成果的信息。该调查基于教学质量 (teaching quality)、学生互动 (learner engagement)、学习资源 (learning resources)、学生支持 (student support)和技能拓展 (skills development) 五大指标，全方面地评价了学生在院校学习的综合教育体验。在 2018 年的 SES 本科阶段学生体验调查中，昆士兰大学以 81.1%的满意度蝉联澳洲八大名校 (Go8)榜首！也是八大名校中唯一一所得分超过 80%的高校。

根据 2018-2019 年的最新数据显示，昆士兰大学在多个权威世界大学排名中都有不俗的成绩，包括：US NEWS 全球最佳大学排名(第 42 位)，QS 全球大学排名(第 47 位)以及世界大学科研论文表现排名(第 40 位)等等。昆士兰大学的优异的教学与科研享誉世界，吸引来自全球的一流研究者。

昆士兰大学有八个世界一流的研究机构和一百多个研究中心，吸引着众多研究者，他们的创举对全球产生着巨大影响。造福全球女性的宫颈癌疫苗加德西(Gardasil)就是在 UQ 发明的。在澳大利亚政府机构发布的 2018 卓越研究报告(ERA)中，昆士兰大学 100%的研究学科均被评为“高于”(above)或“远远高于”(well above)世界标准。

昆士兰大学理学部(Faculty of Science)是全澳最大的科学团体之一，拥有将近 1100 名全职员工和 8500 名在校学生以及超过 1800 个教学和科研实验室，其中包括两座用来教学和科研的岛屿，赫伦岛科研站 (Heron Island Research Station) 和 摩顿湾科研站 (Moreton Bay Research Station)。

在学科单项排名中，目前 UQ 共有 24 个学科名列全球前 50，而理科方向的就占其中的 6 个。

理学部农业与动物，生物制药，化学，食品科学，环境科学等众多学科结合起来，并将其与应用科学密切联系，此举被认作是全球科学界的领袖、杰出的教育单位、科学项目的引擎。优越良好的校园环境和师资力量，令昆士兰大学成为全澳获得最多教学奖项的大学，同时也荣膺八大联盟中学生满意度最高的学府。为了让学生能够充分体会到实用性教育，并为就业打好基础，多个课程的设置中包含了实地考察、工作实践以及海外访学。不仅如此，学校还针对国际留学生设立多项奖学金及各类奖项，为留学生的学习工作生活助力。

关于 2+2 本科联合培养项目

通过昆士兰大学与华东师范大学本科理学学士 2+2 联合培养项目，学生可以在完成华东师范大学理学学士（地理科学或地理信息科学专业）大二课程后进入到昆士兰大学，学习理学学士课程（地理科学

专业）。在完成昆士兰大学的两年本科课程之后，学生可以获得由昆士兰大学以及华东师范大学颁发的两个本科学士学位证书。

- 2、选拔专业：地理信息科学，地理学
- 3、学习成绩：本科前两年综合加权平均分 70 分以上（不含各种奖励性加分）；
- 4、语言要求：雅思总分 6.5 且单项不低于 6.0，或者托福机考总分 87，写作单项不低于 21，其他单项不低于 19，或者 PTE 总分 64，单项不低于 60

学分认证、学位授予说明

- 1、学生在昆士兰大学每年需学习 16 个学分 (16 Units) 本科共计两年

2、华东师范大学认可学生在昆士兰大学取得的课程学分。返校后，根据学校有关规定进行学分认证。

3、顺利完成昆士兰大学的学习要求并达到华东师范大学的毕业条件后，学生将获得华东师范大学和昆士兰大学双学士学位证书。

签证和留学生医疗保险 Visa and OSHC

在昆士兰大学学习期间，你必须持有有效的学生签证和留学生医疗保险。详情请见入学通知书。

全日制学习 Full-time study

昆士兰大学规定，标准的全日制学习每学期需要修满 8 个学分（通常 4 门课程）。持学生签证的国际学生必须在入学确认书（CoE）的截止日期前完成课程。这意味着大多数持有学生签证的学生每学期需要修学 8 个学分。如果你希望改变你的学习计划和修读学分，请联系你的学院获取建议。

学期 Semesters

昆士兰大学一年一般有两个学期，其中第一学期一般从 2 月到 6 月，第二学期一般从 7 月到 11 月。

兼职工作 Part time work

根据学生签证规定，国际学生可以从事兼职或临时工种，每两周累计 40 小时工时，在无授课长假期间可打全职工。兼职打工不可影响到学习，因为学习是学生的首要任务，兼职的主要目的是让学生在学之余通过工作，进一步了解当地的文化，增强语言应用能力，并获得宝贵的工作经验，为将来就业打下良好的基础，而并不是支付学费或生活费。

实习 Internship and Workplace Learning

边学习边在昆士兰的公司进行专业实习是获得实际工作经验的绝佳方法，同时也是在布里斯班拓展人际网络的好机会。学生们通常在学习阶段后期开始实习工作，往往是学业的最后一年，或在研读第二学位或学历时，许多公司及政府部门都为学生提供带薪或无薪专业实习职位安排。

志愿者 Volunteer

师范大学相关老师的同意，再递交联合培养项目申请。
